Objectives and investment policy

The key features of the sub-fund are as follows:

- The Sub-Fund's investment objectives are to deliver sustainable positive returns with attractive Sharpe ratio over a recommended minimum investment period of three years
- while outperforming its reference indicator, calculated with coupons reinvested, and making a positive contribution to society and the environment.

 This Sub-Fund is an actively managed UCITS. The investment manager has discretion over the composition of its portfolio, subject to the stated investment objectives and policy. the Sub-Fund's investment universe is mostly independent from the indicator. The Sub-Fund's investment strategy is not dependent on the indicator; therefore, the Sub-Fund's holdings
- and the weightings may substantially deviate from the composition of the indicator. There is no limit set on the level of such deviation. The reference indicator is the JP Morgan GBI Emerging Markets Global Diversified Composite Unhedged EUR Index.

 In a bid to outperform the reference indicator, the sub-fund is invested mainly in emerging markets debt instruments, without restriction in terms of rating or currency denomination. The sub-fund may also hold ancillary positions in bonds issued by sovereign issuers of developed market countries.  The manager may use Relative Value strategies as performance drivers, looking to take advantage of the relative value between different instruments. Short positions may also be taken through derivatives.
- This Sub-Fund has a sustainable objective to invest in sovereign debt investments whose ESG criteria are dynamically improving in accordance with article 9 of the Sustainable Finance Disclosure Regulation ("SFDR"). The ESG indicators are composed of publicly available data and calculated on a monthly basis. Negative Screening is used to actively reduce the Sub-Fund's corporate bond investment universe by at least 20%. Examples of ESG criteria include for Sovereign issuers (E) share of renewable energy, (S) education ad (G) ease of doing business, and for Corporate issuers (E) carbon emissions data, (S) human capital policies, (G) minority shareholder treatment. With respect to sovereign issuers, the Sub-Fund may not have perfect coverage of all the relevant ESG indicators at all times.


